# DIRECTIONS TO THE CORPORATE EXECUTIVE BOARD OFFICES

## Washington, D.C.

### Metro Directions

#### **When Walking from the Rosslyn Metro Station (Accessible by Blue and Orange Lines)**

- Exit the station toward North Moore Street.
- Turn left and walk toward 19th Street North.
- Cross to the other side of 19th Street North.
- Turn right and walk one block to North Lynn Street.
- Cross North Lynn Street.
- 1919 North Lynn Street is the last building before the Key Bridge.

### Driving Directions

#### **From Baltimore—Travel Time: Approximately One Hour**

- Take I-95 South out of Baltimore toward Washington, D.C.
- Exit onto I-495 West.
- Cross the Legion Bridge at the MD/VA state line.
- Exit onto I-66 East toward Washington, D.C. (left exit).
- Take exit 73 toward Key Bridge/Rosslyn.
- Turn slight right onto Fort Myer Drive.
- Turn left onto 19th Street North.
- Turn left onto North Lynn Street.
- 1919 North Lynn Street is the final building before the Key Bridge.

#### **From Richmond (and Points South)—Travel Time: Approximately Two Hours**

- Take I-95 North.
- Continue onto I-395 North.
- Take exit 8B onto VA-27 (Washington Blvd.) toward Arlington Cemetery/Rosslyn/Pentagon.
- Take the ramp toward Pentagon North Parking Entrance/VA-110.
- Merge onto VA-110 North (Jefferson Davis Highway).
- Turn slight left to take the Wilson Blvd. ramp toward Rosslyn.
- Turn right onto North Lynn Street.
- 1919 North Lynn Street is the final building before the Key Bridge.

#### **From Northern Virginia (and Points West)—Travel Time: Approximately 30 to 45 Minutes**

- Take I-66 East toward Washington.
- Take exit 73 toward Key Bridge/Rosslyn.
- Turn slight right onto Fort Myer Drive.
- Turn left onto 19th Street North.
- Turn left onto North Lynn Street.
- 1919 North Lynn Street is the final building before the Key Bridge.

#### **From Rockville—Travel Time: Approximately 30 to 45 Minutes**

- Take I-270 spur South.
- Merge onto I-495 South (Capital Beltway).
- Take exit 43 toward George Washington Memorial Parkway South.
- Merge onto US-50 West (Arlington Blvd.) toward Rosslyn.
- Turn slight right onto North Lynn Street.
- 1919 North Lynn Street is the final building before the Key Bridge.

# DIRECTIONS TO THE CORPORATE EXECUTIVE BOARD OFFICE

## *Chicago*

CEB's Chicago office is conveniently located in the West Loop section of the city, across the street from Union Station.

#### **Bus, El, Subway and Metra/PACE Access**

All of the subway and El lines are within 5.5 blocks of the office, and Union Station serves as a main hub for Metra trains. Many major bus routes also have stops easily within walking distance of the office. Instructions for purchasing these as well as advice on finding the best route from your home/apartment to the office, can be found on the Chicago Transit Authority Trip Planner Web site at: <http://tripsweb.rtachicago.com/>

#### **Airport Access**

Two major airports service the Chicago area: Midway and O'Hare International Airports. From the airport public transit (Orange Line from Midway or Blue Line from O'Hare), taxi, or car rentals are available. O'Hare is approximately 28 miles from the office, and Midway is approximately 11 miles from the office.

#### **Nearby Parking**

If you are traveling by car, parking is available at the Union Station parking lot located on West Jackson Blvd, and there is a garage in the building with limited parking available (the garage can be accessed by taking Quincy Place, between West Adams and West Jackson).

# DIRECTIONS TO THE CORPORATE EXECUTIVE BOARD OFFICE

## ***San Francisco***

### **Public Transportation: BART**

- The closest BART station is the Montgomery St. Station.
- Walk left down Montgomery to California St.
- Turn left onto California Street and walk to 580.

### **Public Transportation: MUNI**

- The California St. Cable Car stops right in front of our building on the corner of California and Kearny.
- MUNI buses 1,15, 30, 9x, and 45 all stop near the office.
- The cost of a MUNI bus ride is \$1.50, while the Cable Cars are \$5.00.
- Three types MUNI passes can be bought: daily, 3-day, or monthly passes. If boarding a Cable Car with a pass, you must also pay \$1.00.

### **Parking**

There are two parking garages within two blocks of the office.

- St Mary's Square Garage (diagonal to the office, entrances on Kearny and California)
- Portsmouth Square Parking (733 Kearny St.)

### **Taxi**

You can a taxi anywhere in the city. They are metered and trips start at \$3.10, increasing by \$0.45 per 1/5 mile or per minute of wait time. Taxis to or from the major airports will cost about \$45.

### **Airports**

San Francisco International Airport (SFO) and Oakland International Airport (OAK) are the most convenient airports when flying to or from the office. SFO is approximately 20 minutes from the office, while Oakland is about 30 minutes.

The BART runs to both airports:

- To SFO from downtown, take the Millbrae train to SFO
- To OAK from downtown, take the Fremont or Dublin/Pleasanton train to the Coliseum Station. Take AIRBART (additional \$3.00 in cash) to Oakland Airport.

### **Shuttles**

There are various shuttle companies that have service to SFO and Oakland. For trips to SFO, shuttles cost about \$15 per person. To Oakland, trips cost about \$29.
